3. Developed an original concept or significantly contributed to improving the pretreatment, pollution, prevention, and stormwater professionals including industries, regulators, peers and management.
4. Acted in a professional and ethical manner in promoting and working with pretreatment, pollution prevention and stormwater professionals including industries, regulators, peers and management.
5. Six copies of award application. Supporting documents encouraged.

Instructions:

1. Applicants must use the attached form. Other formats will not be accepted.
2. A single nomination for each category of this award may be submitted by each local section for their Local Section winner and CWEA Standing Committee (other than P3S).
3. The CWEA P3S Awards are coordinated by the CWEA P3S Nomination Committee, made up of a chair and four other members. The Committee is chaired by the previous year's winner of Person of the Year. The other members are the most recent recipients of the award who are available to serve.
4. The committee will evaluate all nominees for this award.
5. All award nominees will be notified of their status prior to the CWEA Annual Conference.
