1. Nominee must be a CWEA member. Include proof.
2. Nominee must hold a current Collection Systems certification by CWEA.
3. Include four copies of the nomination packet.
4. Nominee has direct operations/maintenance responsibilities in a collection system. Not more than 10% of candidate's time should be spent performing administrative duties; majority of time must be spent in collection systems function.
5. Organizational chart showing the candidate's position within the organizational structure must be attached.
6. Winner should be willing to serve on the Awards Committee the following year.

9. Applicants must use the attached form. Other formats will not be accepted.
10. Submitted material will not be returned.
11. A single nomination for the State level of this award may be submitted by each Local Section on behalf of their Local Section winner and CWEA Standing Committee.
12. The CWEA Collection Systems Awards are coordinated by the CWEA Collection System Committee Awards Evaluation Team. The team is comprised of the Awards Subcommittee Chair, Committee Chair, and equal representation from the Northern and Southern regions.
13. The team will evaluate all nominees for this award.
14. All nominees will be notified of their award status prior to the CWEA Annual Conference.
